

Cookies policy

The website does not automatically collect any information, except for the information contained in cookies.

Cookies are small pieces of information, or data files, in particular text files, which are stored in the terminal device of the website User (i.e. computer, smartphone or tablet) and are intended for using the website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which the cookie comes from, the time for which they will remain on the terminal device and a unique number. Cookies files are placed on the terminal device of the website User by the operator of the website – MEDCOM Sp. z o.o. with registered seat in Warsaw, 02-230 Jutrzenki 78A, who also has access to the cookies.

Cookies are used to:

- customise the content of the website to the User's preferences and optimise using the website; in particular cookies make it possible to recognise the User's device and display the website adjusted to the individual preferences of the User;
- compile anonymous, aggregated statistics that make it possible to understand how Users use the website, which helps us to improve its structure and content.

Two types of cookies may be used on this website: "session cookies" and "persistent cookies". Session cookies are temporary files that remain on the terminal device of the User's device until he/she leaves the website or disables the software (web browser). A persistent cookie remains on the terminal device of the User for a period specified in the cookie's parameters or until manually deleted by the User.

On this website we use the following cookies:

- necessary cookies, which enable the use of services available on the website, e.g. authentication cookies used for services that require authentication within the website;
- performance cookies, which enable collecting information how Users use the website.

Many internet browsers are initially set up to automatically accept cookies in the terminal device of the User. Website Users may change the cookies settings any time. In particular, Users may change the settings to block cookies, or to alert the User when cookies are being sent to the terminal device of the User. Please refer to your browser instructions or help screen to learn more about how to adjust or modify your browser settings.

Please be aware that disabling cookies may impact some functionalities available on the website.

Our partners or advertisers also may use and send cookies to the terminal devices of website Users.
